SHRIGLEY HALL GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE**

Match Play - Loss of Hole Stroke Play - Two Strokes.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

a) A ball is out of bounds if all of it lies:

- a) On or beyond the wall that forms the boundary of the course, or the internal Oak Ridge (left of the 6th, right of the 10th & 17th holes).
- b) In line with or beyond white posts anywhere on the course.

2. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Incl. IMMOVABLE

OBSTRUCTIONS) (Rule 16.1)

- a) Man-made roads and paths including the track and margins (two club-lengths either side) running down the centre of the 6th fairway and to the right of the green, the grassed over path to the left of the 9th and right of the 17th & 18th fairways, artificial steps, manhole covers, drainage grids together with fixed sprinkler heads, sprinkler control boxes, ropes and posts, and the Building in the middle of the 1st Fairway, are all Immovable Obstructions. You may take free relief under Rule 16.1. If a ball lies in the General Area and an Immovable Obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, you may take free relief as follows:
The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a Penalty Area or on a putting green.
- c) If staked/marked trees interfere with a player's intended stance or swing (but **NOT** the flight of the ball), free relief under Rule 16.1 **MUST** be taken.
- d) Distances, marker posts and plaques must not be removed. Take free relief under Rule 16.1.

3. COLLAPSED DRAINS (Rule 16.1)

Unmarked collapsed drains in the General Area are GUR. It must be known/virtually certain that it is a collapsed drain (eg there is a line of indentations) and you must announce your intention to opponent(s) or fellow-competitor(s). You may take free relief under Rule 16.1.

4. RED DEER DAMAGE (Local Rule F-13)

Other than in a Penalty Area, damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by Red Deer hoofs is ground under repair from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

5. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 15-2)

All Penalty Area (Red) stakes, directional marker posts, benches and Notices e.g. Buggy Direction boards, are movable obstructions.

6. AERATION HOLES (Local Rule E-4)

On the putting green, if a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.

7. PROVISIONAL BALL FOR BALL IN PENALTY AREA

(Local Rule B-3)

If a player does not know whether their ball is in the penalty area on holes 7, 8, 11 or 17, the player may play a provisional ball under Rule 18.3 which is modified thus:

a) If it is known or virtually certain that the ball is in the Penalty Area, you should take relief under Rule 17.1.

b) If it is **not** known or virtually certain that the ball is in the Penalty Area, then you may play a Provisional Ball under penalty of one stroke.

If the original ball is found outside of the Penalty Area within the 3 minute search period, then you must continue with the original ball and there is no penalty.

If the original ball is not found within the 3 minute search period, you must continue play with the Provisional Ball under penalty of one stroke. If you have played a Provisional Ball and the original ball is found in the Penalty Area within the 3 minute search period, you may play the original ball as it lies or you may play the provisional ball, but you cannot use any of the other options under Rule 17.1.
